Position: Child & Family Psychological Services/Integrated Behavioral Associates seeks a full-time Adult Primary Care/Women's Health Psychologist. This position serves the integrated behavioral health program of a major medical center with multiple locations across the South Shore. The candidate will be responsible for providing brief behavioral health assessment, triage, and treatment services to women's health and primary care patients; consultation and support to medical providers and other medical staff; and traditional outpatient mental health services, particularly relating to pre- and post-partum women. Experience with primary care practice is a plus, but training can be provided to the right candidate. The position is embedded 2-3 days per week in a women's health clinic. The other days will be in one of our South Shore outpatient behavioral health offices.

- Doctoral degree from an APA-approved clinical, counseling, or school psychology program is required.
