Seeking energetic, independently licensed Psychologist (PhD / PsyD) or licensed therapist (LMHC / LICSW) with excellent communication skills and clinical acumen to join our team! Behavioral Health Clinicians (BHC) are embedded within Pediatric offices and are integral to primary care teams. They participate in case consultations and are often sought after by Pediatricians for their expertise. Pediatric BHCs work with children, adolescents, and their parents on issues ranging from acute to chronic health conditions, mental health, developmental concerns, and behavioral struggles. BHCs use evidence-based therapies like CBT, Motivational Interviewing, and brief targeted treatment, and conduct screens for ADHD, depression, anxiety, and other conditions. BHCs frequently consult with parents, schools, and medical professionals. Ongoing training and peer support provided.
